Host

Julia Morris is one of Australia's most accomplished and celebrated performers.

A quadruple threat, Julia has seamlessly moved between the stage and the screen for over 35 years.

Julia first appeared on Aussie TV at 17, singing on the talent show *New Faces*. By the mid-nineties Julia was a household name as a headlining stand-up and actor, with starring roles in comedy sketch favourite *Full Frontal*, night-time talk show In *Melbourne Tonight* and comedy panel show, *Beauty and the Beast*.

As a stand-up comedian, Julia has featured in every major comedy festival in the world, taking to the stage with Whoopi Goldberg, Richard Pryor and Robin Williams.

Moving to London in 2000, 'Lady JMo' featured in several British sitcoms, co-hosted *Liquid News*, a daily entertainment show on the BBC while also featuring on several comedy panels including Stephen Fry's *QI*.

Her 2001 solo show won the prestigious Herald Angel Award at the Edinburgh Comedy Festival. With a groundswell of comedy fans, Julia also won *Time Out* London's Comedy Performer of the Year.

In 2008, Julia and Australian Opera star David Hobson won celebrity singing show, It Takes Two.

Having won Best Australian Act at the *Time Out* Sydney 2009 Comedy Awards, Julia relocated her family to Los Angeles, where she studied with Hollywood acting coach, Lesly Kahn.

In late 2011 Julia returned home to become Australia's very first *Celebrity Apprentice*, raising nearly \$200,000 for breast cancer research. By the following year, Julia was cast as the female lead, Gemma Crabb, in the hit drama *House Husbands*. The show established itself as an audience favourite, with Julia being nominated for Most Popular Actress in Australia's *TV Week* Logie Awards for five years in a row.

In 2013 Julia hosted Australia's Got Talent. The same year, her No Judgement stand-up tour won the Helpmann Award for Best Comedy.

Julia has co-hosted Network 10's hit reality show, I'm A Celebrity... Get Me Out Of Here! since it first ventured into the jungle in 2015.

In 2020, Julia appeared as Kitten on **The Masked Singer**, making it to the top four in the semi-finals before being unmasked.

Following this, Julia released the Audible original, Julia Morris Makes it EASY as an audiobook and paperback out in bookstores through HarperCollins Australia.

In 2022, Julia was nominated for the TV Week Gold Logie for Most Popular Personality on Australian Television.

In 2023, Julia went head-to-head against four other comedians in a series of hilarious hijinks on Network 10's hit comedy show, **Taskmaster** and toured her new show, 75 Years In The Business, throughout Australia to sold out audiences.

Host

Robert Irwin and his abundance of energy is contagious. Along with a huge affinity for nature, Robert has a love for wildlife photography, conservation and teaching people about the importance of the natural world.

Robert's favourite animals are crocodiles. He educates thousands of guests about these apex predators by showcasing their natural behaviour in Australia Zoo's daily *Wildlife Warrior's Show*.

He is also part of the annual Australia Zoo crocodile research trip on the Steve Irwin Wildlife Reserve in far North Queensland, helping the experienced croc team catch and tag crocodiles with tracking devices before releasing them back into the wild. Robert is always keen to learn all he can about the biology and behaviours of these modern-day dinosaurs.

He is passionate about his work at Australia Zoo, especially when it comes to reptiles, learning from his mum, Terri, and the amazing zoo team. There is nothing he enjoys more than helping care for their huge family of animals, whether that's training a Komodo dragon, feeding a crocodile or wrangling a snake.

Robert continues to support conservation projects around the world with his family in locations all across the globe, from the African savannah to the Sumatran jungle, and the mangroves of far North Queensland. He is always enthusiastic to share his love of wildlife and wild places, in the hope that he may inspire others to help conserve our planet for the future.

With a long list of outstanding achievements already under his khakis, is there nothing this 20 yr old can't do? Notable achievements include four seasons of the television series *Crikey! It's the Irwins*, lead role in the television series *Steve Irwin's Wildlife Warriors*, co-created and provided illustrations for book series *Robert Irwin: Dinosaur Hunter*, 2009 Nickelodeon Kids Choice Awards winner: Biggest Greenie, 2019 winner Queensland Tourism Award: Young Achiever's Award, 2020 Wildlife Photographer Of The Year: People's Choice Award, 2020 Ambassador for His Royal Highness Prince William's: Earthshot Prize plus numerous award nominations, television appearances and conservation campaigns globally.

Candice Warner

Ironwoman

Candice Warner is one of Australia's most loved sports and media stars. She is recognised for her grit as a former Champion Ironwoman, her glamour as one-half Australia's sporting power couple, and her resilience as someone who has overcome many obstacles – not only surviving but thriving.

A born and bred Maroubra girl, she rose to the top of her sport as a Champion Ironwoman. Having first drawn attention as the sports youngest ever competitor to turn professional at just 14 years old.

Her impressive list of accolades includes three World Championship gold medals and 60 state championship medals (36 of these being gold and two NSW board titles). She has won the 'Queen of Nelson Mandela Bay' in South Africa, the 2013 NSW Ironwoman Championship and has won 20 Australian Championship medals.

Candice has since transferred those skills into a successful media career as a host for Triple M's *Dead Set Legends* every Saturday morning and as a panelist on Fox Sports *Back Page* every Tuesday night. Not one to shy away from a challenge, Candice triumphantly competed in Channel 7's SAS Australia in 2020, fast becoming a fan favourite.

Released in 2023, her memoir: *Running Strong* has received rave reviews and shares a candid, raw and uplifting story of triumph against the odds.

A busy mum to three girls, Candice sets an example that women can be strong, courageous and determined. All while living a life filled with love, purpose, ambition and optimism.



Ellie Cole

Gold Medallist

Paralympian Ellie Cole is like no one you've ever met before.

After losing her right leg to cancer at the tender age of three years, at the 2020 Tokyo Paralympics she became Australia's most decorated female Paralympic athlete. With a record-breaking 17 Paralympic medals and an OAM and more recently an AM to her name, Ellie Cole is an extraordinary individual. Overcoming injuries and adversity, Ellie has risen to prolific heights and was honoured as the flagbearer at the Tokyo 2020 Closing Ceremony.

Ellie is incredibly passionate about the subject of diversity and inclusion, leveraging her strong platform as a media personality and former athlete to highlight important causes like #WeThe15 – a movement that endeavours for disability visibility and representation.

In 2020, Ellie featured in the Netflix original film Rising Phoenix, a documentary that explores global understanding of disability and the excellence that is encouraged by the Paralympic Games.

No stranger to the stage or screen, Ellie has been instrumental in a number of global initiatives to promote diversity and inclusion starring in WOWOW Japan's WHO I Am series, being invited to speak at the Cannes Lions in 2019 on the subject of diversity and inclusion not only in sport but in life, and closer to home partnering with her sponsors to deliver greater awareness of and support for the Paralympic movement and the disability community.

Ellie has appeared in countless magazines and broadcast programs across a variety of networks spanning the 7 Network, ABC, SBS, 9 and Network 10 and most recently was announced as a key member of the Channel 9 commentary team for the Paris Olympic and Paralympics Games in 2024 and as a regular host on 9's *Wide World of Sports* program. Ellie has been featured on the cover of and in the pages of countless magazines – including *Womens Health* and *Body & Soul*, *Vogue*, *Harpers Bazaar*, and many more.

It is Ellie's charisma and her unrivalled sense of humour that make her truly magnetic. She tells her inspiring story with her customary humility, never for a second dwelling on the odds she has beaten to be where she is today.



Frankie Muniz

Child Star

Former child actor turned racing car driver and musician Frankie Muniz is best known for starring as the title character in *Malcom in the Middle*.

Born in Wood-Ridge, New Jersey, Muniz grew up in North Carolina where he was discovered after appearing in a local production of *A Christmas Carol* playing Tiny Tim.

After appearing in several commercials, he made his movie debut in *To Dance with Olivia* in 1997, but his big break came several years later when he landed the title role in the sitcom *Malcolm in the Middle*. The pilot episode was watched by more than 23 million people and Muniz was shot into the spotlight overnight.

His role in the immensely popular Fox sitcom earned him two Golden Globe Award nominations and an Emmy Award nomination, and he went on to star in big screen roles in *Big Fat Liar*, *Deuces Wild*, *Racing Stripes* and *Agent Cody Banks*.

Named one of "Hollywood's most bankable teens" in 2003, he was considered one of the most popular child actors of his generation before putting his acting career on hold to pursue a career as an openwheel racing driver. Muniz competed in the Atlantic Championship and at the Daytona International Speedway in the ARCA Menards Series in 2022.

Away from the worlds of acting and racing cars, the multi-talented Muniz was the drummer of indie rock group Kingsfoil from 2012 to 2014.

Although Frankie has taken numerous breaks from acting to enjoy success in the music industry and as a racing car driver he has continued to appear on screen in the likes of *The Rookie* and as a co-host of *Dancing with the Stars: Juniors*.





Khanh Ong

Celebrity Chef

Khanh Ong, with his charismatic smile and genuine story, has become a household name and a fan favourite from **MasterChef Australia** seasons 10 and 12 plus **Survivor Australia's Blood Vs Water** in 2022.

Born in an Indonesian refugee camp to Vietnamese parents and raised in Melbourne's southeast, Khanh's tale resonates with many.

Life before MasterChef and Survivor, Khanh DJ'd at top venues in both Australia and Asia for international stars like Justin Bieber, Jason Derulo and Miley Cyrus. Having studied fashion design and working as a stylist has given him a distinctive style, making him stand out in the crowd.

Khanh has cooked for icons like Gordon Ramsay and Prince Charles, and his natural charisma has led to his own TV show, *Khanh Ong's Wild Food*.

Part owner of The George on Collins in Melbourne, co-host of *My Market Kitchen* 2019, Youtuber, content creator and now published author, Khanh is perpetually immersed in the food industry.

Fitness Guru

Michelle is one of Australia's most influential personal trainers, a best-selling fitness, nutrition and mindset author and a national commentator on health and wellness issues. With thousands of online clients experiencing amazing well-being and weight loss results – it's no wonder she is one of Australia's most highly regarded health and fitness experts.

She is the author of seventeen books, including her latest release 12WBT Low-Carb Solution. Michelle's other Best-Selling books include Keeping It Off, Food For Life, Make it Happen, Powerful Living, Crunch Time, No Excuses Cookbook, Losing the Last Five Kilos and Your Best Body.

Michelle also has an extensive range of eBooks and DVDs and in 2015, she released her first workout compilation album, Booty Blitz Trax, through Sony Music Australia. The album went straight to #3 on the iTunes Chart.

Her 12 Week Body Transformation (12WBT) program, is now in its 11th year, has had hundreds of thousands of people complete the program and has stripped over 2 million kilos off its members.

Best known as the straight-talking trainer across many series of Network 10's *The Biggest Loser*, Michelle has enjoyed an extensive media career. In 2019, she was a fan favourite on Network 10's *Dancing with The Stars*, and in 2021 appeared on Channel 9's *Celebrity Apprentice*.

Michelle launched her popular MB Active range exclusively to BIG W. Paving the way for inclusive activewear, MB Active was one of the first Australian brands to offer activewear from sizes 8 to 26. She launched Delicious Nutritious with supermarket giant, Woolworths. The Delicious Nutritious range won several Healthy Food Guide Awards during its four-year retail period.

In 2012 Michelle broke a Guinness World Record for the largest circuit fitness class in Melbourne, Australia and broke a second in 2014 for the largest exercise ball class live on NBC's Today Show at Rockefeller Plaza in New York City.

Michelle is also a sought-after public speaker, including featuring as a guest speaker at distinguished events such as The Arnold Schwarzenegger 'Total Success Summit'.

Michelle is a proud mother to seven-year-old son Axel.



Peter Daicos

AFL Legend

AFL legend Peter Daicos is one of the Collingwood Football clubs most loved and decorated champions, who played his entire 250-game career with the club.

His silky and sublime skills had him referred to as the "Magician", and the "Macedonian Marvel" in reference to his parent's heritage.

His outstanding 549-goal, 15-year career earned him entry into the Australian Football Hall Of Fame in 1999. His honours include the 1990 AFL Premiership with Collingwood, and the 1991 Goal of the Year.

In 2005, one of his famous goals from the 1990 finals was featured in a Toyota "Memorable Moments" commercial. Commentators often refer to modern day goals being "Daicos like" as he pioneered highly calculated kicking of a goal that all but seemed impossible.

Since retirement, Peter has been a highly sought-after speaker at business and sporting events and is the father of current Collingwood star premiership players Josh and Nick.

In 2024, Peter is a weekly contributor on Seven's *Sunrise* Program and will do, as his time permits, occasional commentary on Radio 3AW for their live AFL broadcasts.

Stephen K Amos

International Comedian

Making his stand-up comedy debut in 2001, Stephen K Amos has toured the world, bringing his comedy to audiences across the globe.

The BAFTA nominated and RTS award-winning comedian, broadcaster, actor and presenter's signature charisma, charm and rapid-fire wit has made him a household name in the UK and Australia.

A regular face at comedy clubs, Stephen is a prolific writer, his debut DVD Find the Funny was recorded at Sydney's own Enmore Theatre and was released in November 2009.

On top of his stand-up, Stephen is an accomplished actor of stage and screen, impressing critics with West End box office hits *My Fair Lady* and *One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest*.

Stephen has been known to flex his acting chops in both comedic and dramatic roles, appearing in shows including Battyman, Pilgrimage: The Road To Rome, and Prejudice and Pride as well as being a favourite feature on panel shows like QI, Mock the Week, Have I Got News For You, The Wright Stuff, and a favourite guest of Network 10's The Project.

In 2012, Stephen published his memoir, *I Used to Say My Mother Was Shirley Bassey*, full of hilarious and heartwarming stories of his chaotic upbringing as one of seven children, tracking "a life fitting in, standing out, and (almost) always laughing".

TV Host

Tristan MacManus is a TV and stage host, dancer and choreographer. The former Studio 10 host appears on Paramount and 10's **A-League** coverage as a host and sideline reporter.

Tristan began dancing in his hometown of Bray, Ireland and was soon travelling Europe winning many juvenile, junior and amateur competitions before turning professional and representing Ireland on the global scene.
