The breadth of content the ABC delivers for all Australians is incredible. Always free, always advertising-free and always available when Australian audiences want to watch and listen.

When trust and quality journalism matters, Australians turn to ABC News, the number 1 news organisation in the country, delivering compelling journalism and providing clarity and truth to all Australians. Landmark programs that allow newsgathering and investigative journalism to flourish, both within Australia and internationally are a staple of the ABC's schedule. In 2025, the ABC will deliver even more Australian Story, to complement Four Corners, 730 and Q&A on a Monday night. Foreign Correspondent will move to an earlier timeslot, bringing international focus to a new evening, now on Tuesdays and as Donald Trump returns to the White House, Planet America returns to make sense of it all for Australian audiences. Insiders, hosted by David Speers will play a fundamental role in providing commentary and analysis as Australia enters a Federal Election year. And of course, the ABC's role in emergency broadcasting is literally lifesaving. Last year, ABC Emergency Broadcasting was activated for 659 events, with more than 530 of those occurring in regional and rural Australia.

Our audio output is vast, connecting Australians locally, nationally and musically. From Jazz to Classic, triple j to Sport, the agenda-setting Radio National and everything in

between. The ABC and Australia will celebrate triple j's 50th birthday in 2025, One Night Stand will return and audiences will listen to Radio National re-establish itself as Australia's audio destination for thought leadership. A new breakfast show, hosted by Sally Sara has been announced and Radio National also welcomes back Fran Kelly to the prestigious Drive show. With new presenters including Marc Fennell, Tim Burrowes and Vivienne Kelly joining the network in new shows focussing on History and Media. The ABC's radio network is complemented with the broadest podcast and on-demand content available anywhere in Australia. True Crime will be a focus in 2025, with a new podcast series, hosted by Rachael Brown, Unravel: Huntsman something to listen out for.

In Screen, we announce almost 50 hours of Australian scripted content, including returns of some of the biggest Drama and Comedy on Australian Television, Bay of Fires, Austin, The Newsreader, Mother & Son and Mystery Road Origin. With a brand new series, The Family Next Door starring Teresa Palmer launching in the middle of 2025 and our new comedy, Optics starting the year strong. Smash hit Return to Paradise is in development and we expect it to return in late 2025.

In Documentary and Specialist, the ABC delivers the most comprehensive slate in Australia. Three new documentary strands that focus on feature documentaries, True Crime and Religion and Ethics to sit alongside Compass show the ABC's commitment to this vital form of storytelling. Series that Australians love, Muster Dogs, Gardening Australia, Back Roads, Landline all return, as do second series of I Was Actually There and The Assembly. Annabel Crabb returns in long from television, and in an election year, Annabel will host a new landmark parliamentary documentary series. Dr Karl and Dr Ann bring two brand new Science series to the ABC, explaining how the world can be better understood. Amanda Keller, Naz Hussein and Kate Ritchie deliver a brand new format, The Role of a Lifetime, which focusses on parenting and in huge news, the ABC, working with the BBC will bring a brand new series of Walking with Dinosaurs back to Australian audiences in 2025.

2025 will be a huge year for Arts and Music right across the ABC; One Night Stand will return on triple j and on ABC iview, the Classic 100 returns, this year with a focus on the Piano, and to complement this, the ABC will commission a brand new series The Piano, which is taking global audiences by storm. The Piano is one of 6 prime time Arts series on ABC TV in 2025, where we will also broadcast Australian Portrait Artist of the Year, Rachel Griffiths' When the War is Over and returning series, The Art of. hosted by Namila Benson, Creative Types with Virginia Trioli and Take 5 with Zan Rowe.

In Children's, the most comprehensive slate of pre-school

and big kids content continues to thrive – over 84m hours of Bluey was viewed on ABC iview in 2024, with Series 3 alone generating over 20m audience views. There is more Bluey in 2025, in a new form that will delight our younger audiences. We welcome Andy Lee to the ABC with a new animated series Do Not Watch This Show, inspired by his smash hit book, Do Not Read This Book, and we are delighted to have Emma Watkins on the ABC as she hosts Teenage Boss Next Level, with more from Emma to come in 2026. Fizzy & Suds, Hard Quiz kids, Kangaroo Beach, Gardening Australia and our Indigenous Lullaby will all return and make up just some of the broadest slate of Children's & Family content in Australia.

In Entertainment we double down on one of the most successful line ups of programs that the ABC has commissioned. For twenty years, Wednesday night at the ABC has been Entertainment night and that continues in 2025. Hard Quiz, The Weekly, Guy Montgomery's Guy Mont Spelling Bee, Spicks & Specks, Melbourne International Comedy Festival and Gruen all return, complemented on Thursdays with our lifestyle series Grand Designs Australia and Restoration Australia, with a second series of A Bite to Eat with Alice also returning to our screens in 2025.

Many of these series are produced by the ABC's own brilliant internal production studio, and many are developed and produced with Australia's incredible independent production sector. A significant amount of our shows are partnerships with Screen Australia, State Funding bodies and local and international distributors. All of whom pour as much value and commitment on Australian content and stories as the ABC does.

The ABC is for everyone. In 2025, the content that you will watch, listen and engage with has been commissioned to ensure that the ABC reflects Australia, tells bold stories, puts Australians at the centre of our storytelling, and showcases ideas that will inspire us all, allowing the ABC to continue to play a vital role in every Australian's life.


### Mystery Road: Origin S2

#### SYNOPSIS

Optics follows two whip-smart 20-something women (Jenna Owen and Vic Zerbst, The Feed, Nugget is Dead: A Christmas Story) who are unexpectedly promoted to run crisis management PR firm Fritz & Randell, after the death of office patriarch Frank Fritz. As they battle weekly public relations crises from celebrities, sports stars and corporate titans, and power challenges from veteran PR flack Ian Randell (Charles Firth, The Chaser), they slowly come to realise that their firm might have a scandal brewing of its own, and start to wonder: have they been set up to fail?

It's a fast-paced, laugh-out-loud workplace comedy that lifts the veil on everyday office politics and on the corporate spin that inflects all the news we consume.

#### SYNOPSIS

We first met Dale Jennings and Helen Norville in 1986, when a fledgling Dale was desperate to be a star newsreader and Helen was fighting to be taken seriously as a journalist. Now, in 1989, Dale Jennings has become the most beloved name in news, and Helen's fearless international reporting has won her an opportunity to be the first woman to both anchor and produce her own current affairs show, 'Public Eye with Helen Norville'.

Helen and Dale initially take pride in each other's success, until an unexpected and cynical network move sees them pitted directly opposite each other in the cut-throat 6pm time slot. Without warning, these former allies and lovers are plunged into the most ferocious battle in commercial television, and it becomes agonisingly clear that by year's end, only one of them will maintain their long-foughtfor position...

In Documentary, we have introduced three strands – our feature doc strand, true crime documentaries, and half hour slots to accompany Compass.

The Australian Features documentary strand will showcase the country's best contemporary factual storytelling. This world-class strand will enlighten, entertain, move and inspire, cementing ABC iview as the premier destination for the very best Australian feature documentaries.

A compelling slate of **True Crime documentaries** will continue ABC's reputation for telling True Crime stories with integrity and rigor. With an enthralling mix of investigative, historical and bloodless true crime, each series will speak to a bigger societal issue or theme.

A strand of **half-hour documentaries** will also be curated to sit alongside Compass – celebrating a diversity of voices and stories from across the nation.



### Eat The Invaders

#### **SYNOPSIS**

Australia's unique biodiversity is being destroyed by the invasive plants and animals brought here by our colonial ancestors. Pests like Cane Toads, Camels, Carp, Deer, Rabbits and Cats have driven many of our native plants and animals to the brink of extinction. But what if a radical rethink could help turn this problem into an opportunity?

Over six episodes, host Tony Armstrong – with the help of scientists, land carers, an artist and a chef – will attempt to turn our unwanted ecological trash into desirable culinary gold, in a provocative attempt to *Eat The Invaders*.

Inspiring Tony's culinary exploration is artist and curator Kirsha Kaechele and Executive Chef Vince Trim from Tasmania's Museum of Old and New Art (Mona). After years exploring the alchemical possibilities of transforming invasive trash into high cuisine through their project Eat the Problem, they will invite Tony and a special guest to an end-of-episode feast, testing whether we could be helping save our environment by eating an invader.

Will Bob Katter really eat a poisonous cane toad? Is Dr Karl Kruszelnicki really going to consume a cat? And surely not even YouTube punk-rock cook Nat's What I Reckon wants to eat a dumpster dolphin (aka carp)! *Eat The Invaders* is a must-watch ecological and culinary wake up call, connecting each one of us via our food choices to the history and future of this country. We know that eating problem species is not a simple fix-all for our environment – but it's certainly a conversation starter.

#### **SYNOPSIS**

Six passionate graziers from across the country participate in an experiment to see if they can train a puppy to become a Champion Muster Dog in just under 12 months. This third season of the smash hit series sets a new twist; this time both Collies and Kelpies are put to the test as three graziers receive an Australian Border Collie pup and three receive a Kelpie pup as we compare techniques and aptitude to see which breed comes out on top!

In the brand new six-part series we meet Marlene, 60, a single mother running her own property in Bingara, NSW; Renee, 25, who works on her family's organic cattle grazing business in the Central Highlands in QLD; Nathan, 17, Kingaroy, QLD takes on a pup to train just as he is completing his final year of high school; first time father Jack, 30, balances a busy life in the community of Dunkeld, VIC with parenthood and farming; Blythe, 39, an advocate of regenerative farming in Uduc, WA; and Kim, 44, mother of two boys who runs a cropping and grazing business in Kaniva, VIC.

Judges Zoe Millar (Series 2 winner) and Joni Hall (Series 1 participant) are joined by esteemed Sheep Dog Trial judge Barry Knight for the finale as Team Collie and Team Kelpie battle it out over 12 months, but only one pup will claim the title, Champion Muster Dog.

#### SYNOPSIS

As a dual British Australian citizen, Miriam Margolyes has spent the past 40 years of her life coming and going to her home in Australia that she shares with Heather, her life-partner.

But despite New Zealand's close proximity, its historic and ongoing cultural, social, and political ties, Miriam's never explored her country's closest neighbour. She wonders if she hasn't been rather remiss – perhaps even a little dismissive – of a country she knows almost nothing about?

Now, Miriam's been given the opportunity to test her assumptions – and find out what this far-flung country of just over 5 million people is all about.

After being offered a lead role in a new international feature film, produced and shot entirely in New Zealand, it's Miram's chance to pursue a long-awaited adventure. A travelogue like no other, she strikes out far beyond the movie set "in search of the real New Zealand, as the locals know it".

Traversing the very different communities and geographies of New Zealand's North and South Islands, Miriam will discover a country that's entirely unique, and shaping its own, very different identity and destiny.

One of Australia's most renowned interviewers, Leigh Sales mentors Autistic journalism students as they learn their craft and interview famous celebrities.

In each episode our students, working with Leigh, research their guest of the week and plan their questions; culminating in an interview with an A-lister that is disarming, fresh and engaging. The interview offers an opportunity to include diverse voices and their perspectives in conversations of national interest, making for a new and fascinating experience for the interviewee and the audience.

Every episode begins with Leigh joining the students to reveal the guest of the week and help them prepare and clarify their questions. Leigh's relationship with the students grows across the series as they share their passions and perspectives with her.

When the celebrity interviewees enter the students' world, the students are ready to use their questions to reveal the real person behind the public figure and will not accept the usual pre-prepared soundbites.

Each interview is unlike any interview that's ever been seen before.

I Was Actually There is a bold documentary series, brought to us by the team behind You Can't Ask That. It explores defining moments of our recent history through the eyes, ears and voices of those who witnessed them first-hand.

Employing the unfiltered and up-close interviewing style that made You Can't Ask That an international sensation, I Was Actually There uncovers hidden perspectives and never-before-seen footage to create a multi-dimensional, experience-driven picture of the events that shaped Australia.

Each episode unfolds as an oral history, allowing the people with firsthand experience to share their own stories, on their own terms. From key players to accidental bystanders, all perspectives are important.

Can a single moment shape the rest of your life? How do our memories of the past play out in our present? Is it true that what doesn't kill you makes you stronger? By asking these questions, *I Was Actually There* allows us to reflect on why these moments matter, and how they make us who we are.

### Orca: Australia's Megapod

Orcas are the apex predators of the ocean. A recently discovered population in Bremer Bay, Western Australia - a megapod of over 150 animals - has managed to achieve the impossible - hunt and kill a blue whale - the largest animal to have ever lived. So, how did they do it?

We join Australia's leading killer whale scientists as they try to piece together what's become one of the most intriguing puzzles in nature.

So far, their findings are rewriting Orca science. Using tracking equipment, hydrophones, ROVs, cameras and a crossbow - the team hope to uncover how the Orcas' family structure, communication strategy and genetic diversity set them apart.

Over 10 summers, they've got to know many by name, like El Notcho, a huge male with a 2m high dorsal fin, and observed them as they socialise and hunt. Each new event documented helps unpick the mystery of how blue whales are killed.


### The Kimberley



From the 10 teams who made digital shorts in 2023, three projects have been selected to make 30 minute pilots for broadcast, digital and social.

Directed by Munasib T Hamid and co-written by Kevin Duo Han and Mark Mariano, the story follows three young adults navigating the challenges of their unfulfilling jobs while contending with cultural clashes and personal dilemmas. 
